**Updates / Reports – by Alice** 

- **Budget** on most line items, we are on budget, or doing slightly better than budget. T-shirts were unbudgeted, but we've sold 52 out of 72 ordered. Membership donations for 2017 totaled \$4,340, and we already have collected \$1,140 for 2018.
